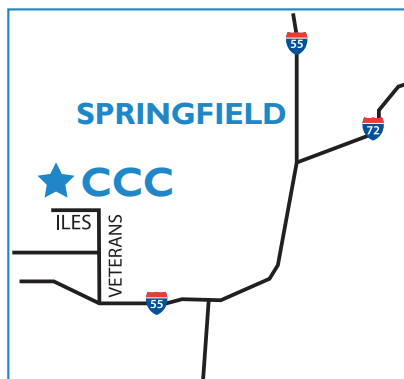

### Knights of Columbus Council 364

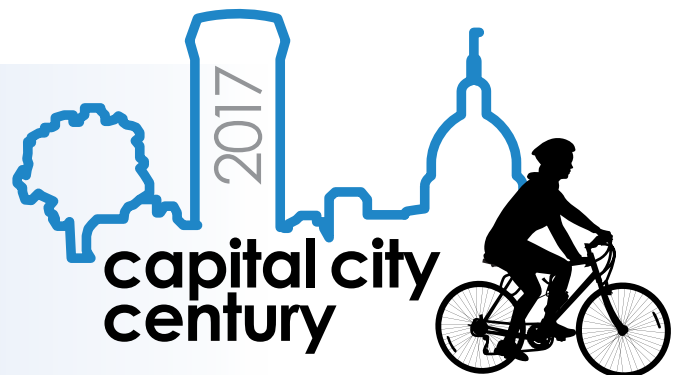
- 2200 South Meadowbrook Road (at W. Iles Ave) Springfield IL 217-787-2360
- Take Exit 93 off I-72 (Veterans Parkway exit)
- Go north on Veterans Parkway for 2 miles
- Turn left onto Iles Avenue and head west 1.3 miles
- Turn right onto Meadowbrook Road. K of C is on right
- Additional parking at YMCA, west on Iles at Archer
